Level 3 Announces Proposed Private Offering of Senior Notes

BROOMFIELD, Colo., January 14, 2015 — Level 3 Communications, Inc. (NYSE: LVLT) announced that its subsidiary, Level 3 Financing, Inc., plans to offer \$500 million aggregate principal amount of senior unsecured notes that will mature in 2023 and will bear interest at a fixed rate in a proposed private offering to “qualified institutional buyers,” as defined in Rule 144A under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and non-U.S. persons outside the United States under Regulation S under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended. Level 3 Financing, Inc.’s obligations under the notes will be fully and unconditionally guaranteed on an unsecured basis by Level 3 Communications, Inc.

The net proceeds from the offering of the notes, together with cash on hand, will be used to redeem all \$500 million aggregate principal amount of Level 3 Financing, Inc.’s 9.375% Senior Notes due 2019.

The senior notes will not be registered under the Securities Act of 1933 or any state securities laws and, unless so registered, may not be offered or sold except pursuant to an applicable exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 and applicable state securities laws.

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Level 3 Announces Pricing of Private Offering of Senior Notes

BROOMFIELD, Colo., January 14, 2015 — Level 3 Communications, Inc. (NYSE: LVLT) today announced that Level 3 Financing, Inc., its wholly owned subsidiary ("Level 3 Financing"), has agreed to sell \$500 million aggregate principal amount of its 5.625% Senior Notes due 2023 in a private offering to "qualified institutional buyers," as defined in Rule 144A under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and non-U.S. persons outside the United States under Regulation S under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended.

The new 5.625% Senior Notes were priced to investors at 100 percent of their principal amount and will mature on February 1, 2023. Level 3 Financing's obligations under the 5.625% Senior Notes will be fully and unconditionally guaranteed on an unsecured basis by Level 3 Communications, Inc.

The net proceeds from the offering of the notes, together with cash on hand, will be used to redeem, satisfy and discharge, defease or otherwise repay or retire all of Level 3 Financing's approximately \$500 million outstanding aggregate principal amount of 9.375% Senior Notes due 2019.

The offering is expected to be completed on January 29, 2015, subject to the satisfaction or waiver of customary closing conditions.

The 5.625% Senior Notes will not be registered under the Securities Act of 1933 or any state securities laws and, unless so registered, may not be offered or sold except pursuant to an applicable exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 and applicable state securities laws.
