(The RSUs vest as to 1/16th of the total shares on February 15, 2014 and then an additional 1/16th of the total shares vest quarterly thereafter, subject to continued service through each vesting date.

(The RSUs vest as to 1/16th of the total shares on May 15, 2016 and then an additional 1/16th of the total shares vest quarterly thereafter, subject to continued service through each vesting date.

(The RSUs vest as to 1/5th of the total shares on February 15, 2016, after which 1/20th of the total shares vest quarterly, subject to continued service through each vesting date.
