Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Each share of Series B Common Stock automatically converts into Series A Common Stock on a 1-for-1 basis, which in turn was reclassified into one share of Common Stock, immediately and automatically upon closing of the Issuer's initial public offering of Common Stock and has no expiration date or conversion price.
- (2) The option is early exercisable. 1/4th of the shares subject to the option will vest on August 30, 2014 and 1/48th of the shares subject to the option shall vest monthly thereafter, subject to the Reporting Person's continuous service to the Issuer on each such date. Unvested shares are subject to acceleration upon the occurrence of certain events.
- (3) Each share of Series A Common Stock was reclassified in an exempt transaction pursuant to Rule 16b-7 into one share of Common Stock immediately prior to the closing of the Issuer's initial public offering and following the conversion of each series of the Issuer's Convertible Preferred Stock and the Issuer's Series B Common Stock into Series A Common Stock.
